**Existing Programs**

**Description:** At MyTeachingPartner, our focus is on teacher-child interactions as the core "curriculum" in early education settings. Our goal is to partner with teachers to provide information and support for high-quality teacher-child interactions (focused on language, literacy, and teacher-child relationships) necessary to promote children's learning and development and to enhance teachers' sense of confidence and efficacy. MTP uses Internet technologies (including net-based videoconferencing) to observe each teacher's own classroom practices and interactions with children, and to offer individualized feedback and support to teachers based on that observation. In this way, we support teachers' high quality implementation and teacher-child interactions. We will be rigorously testing this model in the evaluation studies we conduct over the next five years.
